#### SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism or as a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In order to receive a Sponsor Certificate from Holy Rosary, one needs to be a registered parishioner of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, must be over 14 years of age and if married, must be in a valid Church marriage (have been married in the presence of a priest/deacon and two witnesses). Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only AFTER Mass on Saturday evening or AFTER any of the other Sunday Masses.

The PERSON REQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE MUST see the priest AFTER ATTENDING THE MASS and request one.


