## FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



### LENTEN MISSION

Our Annual Lenten Mission will be held this year with the other parishes in our Cluster Group (Saint Ann's, Saint Christopher/Saint Margaret Mary and Saint Sylvester).

The Mission will be held at Saint Ann's Church located at 101 Cromwell Avenue on Monday March 6th through Wednesday March 8th. The talks will take place at 7:00 pm on each of these nights.

*Father Paul Bryan, CSsR, a Redemptorist missionary and Sister Mary Sninsky, OSF, a Bernardine Franciscan* will lead the Parish Mission.

There will be a mission talk in the morning after the 9:00 am Mass and an evening service at 7:00 pm. The evening service includes prayer, hymns and mission talk.

On Tuesday evening, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. On Wednesday evening there will be Mass in honor of Mary under the title of Our Mother of Perpetual Help.

### LENTEN GUIDELINES

During the Season of Lent, our Church recommends that all the Faithful reflect a spirit in penance in their daily life through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

**FASTING** requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige until age 59. Those not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

**ABSTINENCE** prohibits individuals from eating meat. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and above. Children and adolescents should be encouraged to join in this discipline to the extent that they are able.
