### We Welcome the New Principal of Holy Rosary School, Mrs. Elizabeth Ann Campbell

**Educational Background:** 1994 Graduate of St. Joseph Hill Academy, 1998 Undergraduate of St. John's University (Bachelor's of Arts in Speech Pathology), 2003 Graduate of St. John's University (Master's of Science in Special Education) 2019 Projected Graduate of Fordham University Master's of Science in School Administration and Supervision)

**Employment Background:** After I graduated with my Bachelor's degree, I began working in Special Education. Six years was spent in the Special Education sector and I wore many hats being a Speech Teacher, Special Education Itinerant Teacher, Educational Therapist, and Special Education Teacher. I began a novena to the Sacred Heart in the summer of 2004 after I was injured at a job that resulted in unemployment.
