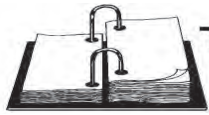

Holy Rosary School of Religion Registration for 2017-2018

Registration for NEW Students to the Program
Will be held at the following times:
Sunday, June 4th, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Church
Monday, June 5th, 6 to 8 pm - School
Tuesday, June 6th, 4 to 6 pm - School
Wednesday, June 7th, 4 to 6 pm - School

Children entering Grade 1 in a public school in September whose families are registered parishioners should be enrolled in our religious education program. If you are re-registering your child for September, you were sent a form which must be returned to the office or rectory no later than August 1st.

Children transferring from another CCD program must request a transfer from that program.
Tuition is required to be paid in full before the start of the program.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO PARENTS OF CHILDREN NEEDING THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST COMMUNION or CONFIRMATION PRIVATE CATHOLIC ACADEMIES

Children attending Private Catholic Academies are required to receive the Sacraments in the Parish where they are registered. The children who are entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2017 should register now for the Sacraments.
