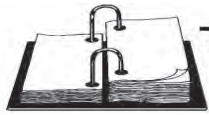

## SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

### Holy Rosary School of Religion Registration for 2017-2018

Registration for NEW Students to the Program  
Will be held at the following times:  
Sunday, June 4th, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Church  
Monday, June 5th, 6 to 8 pm - School  
Tuesday, June 6th, 4 to 6 pm - School  
Wednesday, June 7th, 4 to 6 pm - School

Children entering Grade 1 in a public school in September whose families are registered parishioners should be enrolled in our religious education program. If you are re-registering your child for September, you were sent a form which must be returned to the office or rectory no later than August 1st.

Children transferring from another CCD program must request a transfer from that program.  
*Tuition is required to be paid in full before the start of the program.*

**Needed at the time of Registration are:**  
**Child's BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE**  
**Parents' Church Envelope Number**

**Fee: \$175 for one child or \$ 230 per family**

### SPECIAL NOTICE TO PARENTS OF CHILDREN NEEDING THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST COMMUNION or CONFIRMATION PRIVATE CATHOLIC ACADEMIES

Children attending Private Catholic Academies are required to receive the Sacraments in the Parish where they are registered. The children who are entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2017 should register now for the Sacraments. Registration for these children will be held on the dates listed above. *Needed at time of registration are Child's Baptismal Certificate, Parents' Church envelope number and a non-refundable registration fee of \$25.*

SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the *Sacrament of Baptism* or as a Sponsor for the *Sacrament of Confirmation*. In order to receive a *Sponsor Certificate* from Holy Rosary, one needs to be a *registered parishioner* of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, must be over 14 years of age and if married, must be in a valid Church marriage (have been married in the presence of a priest/deacon and two witnesses). Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only **AFTER** Mass on Saturday evening or **AFTER** any of the other Sunday Masses.

The **PERSON REQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE MUST** see the priest **AFTER ATTENDING THE MASS** and request one.
