Children entering Grade 1 in a public school in September whose families are registered parishioners should be enrolled in our religious education program. If you are re-registering your child for September, you were sent a form which must be returned to the office or rectory no later than August 15th.

Children transferring from another CCD program must request a transfer from that program.  
*Tuition is required to be paid in full before the start of the program.*

**Needed at the time of Registration are:**  
**Child's BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE**  
**Parents' Church Envelope Number**  
**Fee: \$200 for one child or \$ 250 per family**

### SPECIAL NOTICE TO PARENTS OF CHILDREN NEEDING THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST COMMUNION or CONFIRMATION PRIVATE CATHOLIC ACADEMIES

Children attending Private Catholic Academies are required to receive the Sacraments **in the Parish where they are registered**. The children who are entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2019 should register now for the Sacraments. Registration for these children will be held on the dates listed above.

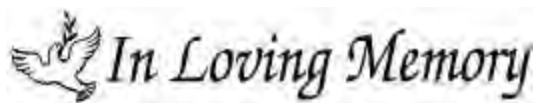
