SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the *Sacrament of Baptism* or as a Sponsor for the *Sacrament of Confirmation*. In order to receive a *Sponsor Certificate* from Holy Rosary, one needs to be a *Registered Parishioner* of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, must be over 14 years of age and if married, must be in a valid Church marriage (have been married in the presence of a priest/deacon and two witnesses). Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only **AFTER** Mass on Saturday evening or **AFTER** any of the other Sunday Masses. The **PERSON REQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE MUST** see the Priest **AFTER ATTENDING THE MASS** and request one.

**Holy Rosary School of Religion

Children entering Grade 1 in a public school in September whose families are registered parishioners should be enrolled in our religious education program. If you are re-registering your child for September, you were sent a form which must be returned to the office or rectory *no later than August 15th*.

Children transferring from another CCD program must request a transfer from that program. *Tuition is required to be paid in full before the start of the program.*

Children attending Private Catholic Academies are required to receive the Sacraments **in the Parish where they are registered**. The children who are entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2019 should register now for the Sacraments. Registration for these children will be held by appointment.
