FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Holy Rosary Update

Until further notice, all public celebrations of Mass have been suspended in the Archdiocese of New York. This means that there will be no daily or Sunday Masses until further notice.

This means that the priests of the parish have been and will continue to offer daily Mass privately for all scheduled Mass Intentions.

Funeral Masses are permitted with strict guidelines and safety measures in place.

Confessions are available at the Rectory By Appointment.

Public Stations of the Cross on Fridays are cancelled.

No decision has yet been made regarding Holy Week and Easter Sunday. Once one is made, I will pass it on to you.

The Rectory Office remains open as normal.

CCD classes are cancelled until further notice and school will be closed until April 20th.

I will keep you informed as new information is received from the Archdiocese.

All parish events, meetings and sports have been cancelled.

We pray that through the intercession of Saint Patrick and Saint Rocco, we will be given the strength to make it through this current health crisis.

LENTEN GUIDELINES

During the Season of Lent, our Church recommends that all the Faithful reflect a spirit in penance in their daily life through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

FASTING requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige until age 59. Those not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals from eating meat. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and above. Children and adolescents should be encouraged to join in this discipline to the extent that they are able.

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY
Are days of fast and abstinence.

FRIDAYS in Lent are days of abstinence.
