Classes Resume today September 12th

- Children entering Grade 1 in a public school in September whose families are registered parishioners should be enrolled in our religious education program.
- If you are re-registering your child for September, please complete the Google Form registration that was emailed to you as soon as possible.
- Children transferring from another CCD program must request a transfer from that program.

Registration will ONLY be done through Google Forms. Please email Ms Guido at holyrosaryschoolofreligion@gmail.com for the registration form.

After you register you can pay for your registration fee (\$200 for one child/\$250 per family) by cash, check or money order one of two ways:

1. Making an appointment with Ms. Guido (holyrosaryschoolofreligion@gmail.com or 718-273-6695
2. Mailing a check made out to Holy Rosary CCD to Holy Rosary Rectory (80 Jerome Ave.) with attention Ms. Guido on the envelope.

The registration fee is due as soon as possible. The registration fee is **required** to be paid in full before the start of the program.

If you are new to the program please bring your child(ren)'s baptismal certificate to his/her registration.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO PARENTS OF CHILDREN NEEDING THE SACRAMENTS OF FIRST COMMUNION or CONFIRMATION WHO ATTEND PRIVATE CATHOLIC ACADEMIES

Children attending Private Catholic Academies are required to receive the Sacraments **in the parish where they are registered**. The children who are entering **Grade 2 or 7 in September 2021** should register now for the Sacraments.

Needed at the time of registration for Sacraments are:

- Child's Baptismal Certificate
- Parents' Church envelope number
- A non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00
