On Sunday, November 28th, I was informed by the Archdiocese that effective December 1st, Father Willy would be transferred to Holy Child Parish in Eltingville as Parochial Vicar. Holy Child is a very large South Shore Parish which is extremely busy and understaffed. The need there was immediate hence the speed of the transfer and the suddenness of the announcement.

We are grateful to Father Willy for his 15 months of service to Holy Rosary Parish and for his work with the homebound, Knights of Columbus, Columbiettes, Rosary Altar Society and Legion of Mary. His homilies at mass were likewise appreciated.

Father will be missed and we keep him in our prayers as he begins his new ministry to the people of Holy Child.

Due to the extreme shortage of priests (there are no ordinations in May), there is no replacement priest available to come to Holy Rosary. I will therefore be the only priest assigned here for the foreseeable future and will also be continuing my role as Judge, Defender of the Bond and Promoter of Justice for the Archdiocesan Tribunal.

Father Patrick Anthony and Father Andrew Ilegbemi have both graciously agreed to assist me with covering the sacramental duties (masses and funerals) here in the parish. However, their assignment and first responsibility continues to be Staten Island Hospital. I am grateful for any assistance that they give us.

While I will do my best to continue serving the parish without disruption, I also ask your understanding as some changes will have to be made as we transition from a two man parish to a one man parish for the foreseeable future.

Please continue to pray for Holy Rosary Parish and your priests.

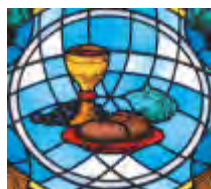
