## Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

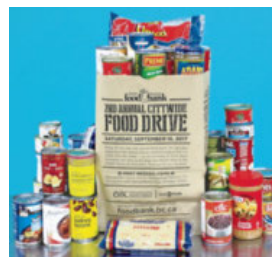

**SPONSOR CERTIFICATES**

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the *Sacrament of Baptism* or as a Sponsor for the *Sacrament of Confirmation*. In order to receive a *Sponsor Certificate* from Holy Rosary, one needs to be a *Registered Parishioner* of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, must be over 14 years of age and if married, must be in a valid Church marriage (have been married in the presence of a priest/deacon and two witnesses). Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only **AFTER** any of the Sunday Masses.

The **PERSON REQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE MUST** see the Priest **AFTER ATTENDING THE MASS** and request one.
